



THE CHALLENGE

Harlequin F.C is a professional rugby union club that plays in Premiership Rugby, the **top level of English rugby union**. Their home ground is the Twickenham Stoop, located in south-west London.

Harlequins decided to replace its existing **screens** on the ground with bigger and better quality ones to **offer an enhanced experience to fans**.

They were looking for a partner that could support them in purchasing the equipment **over a period of time** and Econocom were recommended to them.



THE SOLUTION

Econocom built a **rental solution** for Harlequins' news screens allowing them to **spread costs and switch to an OPEX model**.
